Use for Peer Feedback Students share with the class one thing that is being worked on such as strong leads. After the student has shared, the class raises their hands to level that they feel the item has met the criteria - no verbal comments necessary as student who shared has a very quick visual of where they are at - all the way up is "hot" or excellent - half way up is "mild" or okay, ...
